General Terms and Conditions GTC: The GTC in this Version 1 shall be applicable starting 1 July 2008 for all BLS and AED courses. We reserve the right of modify the GTC at any time and without prior notice. The current version of the GTC at the time of registration shall apply.

Organization: The courses are organized and run by Sky Unlimited GmbH. Instructor in charge is Othmar Zimmermann, Certified Emergency Medical Technician and BLS-AED Instructor SRC.

The course and instruction times are those published on the registration form. A minimum number of participants are required for the course to be run. We expressly reserve the right to cancel or combine courses in the event of insufficient registration. Groups, companies or other institutions may arrange for a course to be run at a date of their choice. Teaching language is German unless otherwise agreed.

Registration: Each participant shall apply by completing and sending in a registration form. By prior arrangement with Sky Unlimited GmbH, group registration may be accepted from a group representative. Registration is a binding commitment to attend the course.

Invoice / Payment: The invoice will be addressed by e-mail or post to the participant's address indicated on the registration form. The amount is to be remitted in full within 10 days as per invoice date. Registrations will be accepted in the sequence of payment received.

Insurance: Sky Unlimited GmbH declines all responsibility for any damages and/or injuries incurred during its courses. Each participant shall be responsible for taking out adequate insurance at his/her own charge. BLS Course (Basic Life Support)

Aim:	Ability to provide first-aid reanimation. Advanced background knowledge with respect to heart disease.

AED (Automatic External Defibrillation)

In the event of an acute cardiac emergency with cardiac arrest, reanimation measures must be initiated immediately. In this course participants will learn to use the layman's defibrillator (AED) in connection with cardiopulmonary resuscitation (BLS) while awaiting the arrival of professional emergency assistance.

The most frequent cause of cardiac arrest is cardiac arrhythmia. The sooner the first responder begins with defibrillation, the greater the chance of successful reanimation.

AED Basics Course:

Aim:	Practical ability to perform early defibrillation as a first responder. Advanced background knowledge with respect to heart disease.
Contents:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Purpose and use of early defibrillation ➤ Refresher on the cardiovascular system ➤ Advanced knowledge on the electrical conduction system ➤ Recognizing the main types of arrhythmia ➤ Practical, safe BLS training with early defibrillation ➤ Various sample cases enabling use of the AED
